DISPOSITION: MOTION FOR WAIVER OF RULE GRANTED

On April 9, 2014, Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Oregon filed a motion seeking waiver of OAR 860-001-0430(2). That rule requires the Commission to decide whether to substantively consider a petition for declaratory ruling within 60 days of its filing.


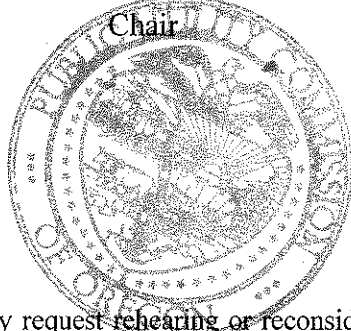
Staff explains that the Renewable Energy Coalition filed this petition for declaratory ruling on February 10, 2014, and the 60-day deadline for Commission action expires on April 11, 2014. Staff has not completed its review and requests more time to prepare a recommendation on whether the Commission should substantively consider the request. Staff adds that Renewable Energy Coalition does not object to the motion.

Staff's motion to waive OAR 860-001-0430(2) is granted. Staff states it will present its recommendation on the petition at our May 15, 2014 Regular Public Meeting.


