DISPOSITION: ORDER. NO. 14-239 CORRECTED

In Order No. 14-239, I erroneously stated that the Sunriver Owners Association (SROA) filed what I treated as a motion for a general protective order. The motion was actually filed by Sunriver Water, LLC, and the order should be corrected to accurately reflect that fact.

Accordingly, the first two paragraphs of Order No. 14-239 are modified to read:

On June 24, 2014, Sunriver Water, LLC (Sunriver Water) filed a motion to limit access to confidential information. Sunriver Water makes the request because it anticipates that it will file in the proceeding information that it considers to be classified, such as Sunriver Water's employees' names and salaries. Sunriver Water requests that the access to such information be limited.

I treat Sunriver Water's motion as one for a general protective order and grant it. The general protective order, which is attached as Appendix A, permits the broadest possible discovery consistent with the need to protect confidential information. It shields no specific documents and makes no judgment about whether any particular document contains a trade secret or commercially sensitive information. Rather, the order adopts a process for resolving discovery disputes that include sensitive information.

The remainder of the order is unchanged.
