ORDER

DISPOSITION: CHARGES ASSESSED

The Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission) has designated its files on the subject of this matter as the record in this case. Based on information contained in those files, the Commission makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

VOLARIS TELECOM LLC is a telecommunications provider required to submit quarterly contribution worksheets and payments to the Commission for the Oregon Universal Service Fund (OUSF). *See* ORS 759.425, and OAR 860-032-0620.

VOLARIS TELECOM LLC failed to meet all or part of the requirements specified above by the due date(s) as set out in OAR 860-032-0620(3).

The Commission sent a Proposed Order to VOLARIS TELECOM LLC on July 28, 2014. VOLARIS TELECOM LLC did not respond.

Pursuant to OAR 860-032-0620 and OAR 860-032-0630, the Commission has proposed VOLARIS TELECOM LLC owes \$100.00 which can include any or all of the following: contribution payment(s), late payment penalty(ies), interest and late statement fee(s), including any portion due but not paid for the period(s). These charges are for the 1st quarter of 2014.

Where applicable, the interest amount is calculated as of the date of this order. The interest will continue to accrue at 9 percent per annum until the Commission receives full contribution payment. Conclusions

VOLARIS TELECOM LLC failed to meet its filing obligations required by law. The amount set forth above should be assessed, with the exception that any applicable interest will continue to accrue at 9 percent per annum until the Commission receives full contribution payment.

ORDER

- 1. The above amounts are assessed against VOLARIS TELECOM LLC and are immediately due and payable to the Public Utility Commission, PO Box 2153, Salem, Oregon 97308-2153.
- 2. Where applicable, interest will continue to accrue at 9 percent per annum until the Commission receives full contribution payment.
