ORDER

DISPOSITION: CHARGES ASSESSED

The Public Utility Commission (Commission) has designated its files on the subject of this matter as the record in this case. Based on information contained in those files, the Commission makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

TELECARE INC. is a telecommunications provider required to submit an annual gross revenue fee statement and fee payment to the Commission. *See* ORS 756.310, ORS 756.320, and OAR 860-032-0095.

TELECARE INC. failed to submit the statement and payment by the due date of April 1, 2016. See OAR 860-032-0095.

The Commission sent a Proposed Order to TELECARE INC. on May 24, 2016. TELECARE INC. did not respond.

Pursuant to OAR 860-032-0097, the Commission has proposed an assessment of charges in the amount of \$208.00. This amount includes the outstanding annual fee; a late statement fee pursuant to OAR 860-001-0050(3); and late payment penalty pursuant to OAR 860-001-0050(2). The late payment penalty is calculated as of the date of this order and will continue to accrue monthly until the Commission receives full payment. Conclusions

TELECARE INC. failed to provide an annual gross revenue statement and fee payment required by law. The proposed amounts set forth above should be assessed, with the exception that the late payment penalty will continue to accrue at two percent (2%) per month on the balance of the annual fee due until the Commission receives full payment.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that the above amounts are assessed against TELECARE INC. and are immediately due and payable to the Public Utility Commission, PO Box 2153, Salem, Oregon 97308-2153.
