ORDER

DISPOSITION: COMPLAINT DISMISSED; DOCKET CLOSED

On November 18, 2016, complainant filed a complaint against Qwest Corporation, dba CenturyLink. On December 14, 2016, counsel for CenturyLink advised the Commission that the parties had reached a settlement and requested the complaint be dismissed with prejudice. On December 23, 2016, complainant confirmed the parties' settlement and requested the Commission dismiss the complaint without prejudice.

CenturyLink stated in its December 14 letter that it has "made a full credit" to complainant's account "leaving a \$0.00 balance." Complainant indicated in the motion to dismiss filing of December 23 that it "anticipates no further litigation on this matter." I find that, the defendant having satisfied all the terms of the settlement by relinquishing all past claims against the complainant, the complainant will not be harmed if the complaint is dismissed with prejudice.


**ORDER**

IT IS ORDERED THAT the complaint filed by Matthew Steven, dba GeniusWeb.com, against Qwest Corporation, dba CenturyLink, is dismissed with prejudice and this docket is closed.
