**ORDER** 

Revised 2016 Renewable Portfolio Implementation Plan.

DISPOSITION: ORDER NO. 17-004 AMENDED TO INCLUDE ADDITIONAL CONDITION TO 2016 RPIP ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

We modify Order No. 17-004 pursuant to ORS 756.658 to make our acknowledgment of Portland General Electric Company's (PGE) 2016 Renewable Portfolio Implementation Plan (RPIP) consistent with our acknowledgment of PacifiCorp's 2017-2021 RPIP.<sup>1</sup>

On April 13, 2016, we provided notice of our intent to modify Order No. 17-004 to add an additional condition requiring additional analysis if PGE commences a resource procurement action that deviates from its most recently acknowledged RPIP or Integrated Resource Plan (IRP). No party filed an objection to our proposal, and the time for doing so has passed.

Accordingly, Order No. 17-004 is amended to read, in its entirety, as follows:

This order memorializes our decision, made and effective at our January 4, 2017 Special Public Meeting, to acknowledge Portland General Electric Company's 2016 Renewable Portfolio Standard Implementation Plan (RPIP) with the following conditions:

- (1) PGE must provide the analysis required by Order No. 16-157 in a manner; and timeframe suitable to both PGE and Staff; and
- (2) Staff will convene workshops to address, on a generic basis with PGE, PacifiCorp, and interested persons, the goal of, and possible revisions to, the RPIP process; and

- THEFT
  - (3) PGE must comply with the following steps when it commences a resource procurement action, for the purpose of complying with the Renewable Portfolio Standards (RPS) law, that materially deviates from its most recently filed Integrated Resource Plan or RPIP;
    - (a) Calculate new incremental costs with the new resource or resources included over a time period acceptable to PGE and Staff; and
    - (b) Respond to requests by the Commission regarding its new analysis arising out of the calculation set forth above.
