DISPOSITION: STIPULATION ADOPTED

On July 27, 2017, the Public Utility Commission of Oregon filed a complaint against defendant. The complaint charged defendant with one violation of law, OAR 952-001-0050, and requested a penalty of \$1,000. On July 27, 2017, a copy of the complaint was served.

On July 27, 2017, the parties in these proceedings entered into a stipulation, which is attached as Appendix A.

Under the terms of the stipulation, defendant admits committing the alleged violation and agrees that the Commission may enter an order assessing civil monetary penalties. Defendant also agrees to complete, within 45 days following the entry of a final order, a training session with the Oregon Utility Notification Center Speakers Bureau on Oregon excavation laws. A review of the Commission's records indicates that the defendant has completed the training session for excavation laws.

The parties further agree that the penalties should be suspended, unless defendant fails to comply with any provision of the stipulation or violates any rule adopted by the Oregon Utility Notification Center under ORS 757.552 for a period of one year following the date of the Commission's final order in these proceedings.

The stipulation is adopted. From the foregoing, it is concluded that no hearing is required. Under the terms of the stipulation, the allegations of the complaint are true, and defendant has violated Oregon Administrative Rules as alleged. Under the provisions of ORS 757.993, penalties should be assessed against defendant under the terms and conditions of the stipulation.

#### ORDER

### IT IS ORDERED that:

- The stipulation, attached as Appendix A, is adopted. 1.
- 2. Civil monetary penalties shall be assessed against Curtis Heintz Excavating, Inc., in the amount of \$1,000 for one violation of law.
- 3. Payment of the penalties (\$1,000) shall be suspended, unless a showing is made that defendant has violated, within one year of the date of this order, any rules administered by the Oregon Utility Notification Center.

A party may appeal this order by filing a petition for review with the Court of Appeals in compliance with ORS 183.480 through 183.484.

2	The parties further agree that the Commission may enter an order assessing civil
3	monetary penalties against Defendant in the amount of \$1,000 under the following terms and
4	conditions:
5	A. Defendant must sign and return this Stipulation within 20 days of the date it was
6	served upon (mailed to) Defendant.
7	B. Payment of the penalty (\$1,000) is suspended and will be waived with no further
8	penalties imposed for the violation alleged in the Complaint unless Defendant fails to
9	comply with all of the terms of this Stipulation and all of the rules adopted by the
10	Oregon Utility Notification Center (OUNC) under ORS 757.552 for a one-year perio
11	following the date of the Commission's entry of an order.
12	C. Defendant must contact the OUNC Speakers Bureau online at
13	www.digsafelyoregon.com or by calling (503) 232-1987 to arrange for and ensure
14	that all of Defendant's employees that engage in excavation activity as part of their
15	job duties, including but not limited to notifying the Oregon Utility Notification
16	Center of proposed excavations, attend a training session on Oregon excavation laws
17	within 45 days following the entry of the Commission's order.
18	D. Defendant must take a blank copy of the Training Verification form attached to this
19	Stipulation as Attachment 1 to all required trainings scheduled under paragraphs 4.C.
20	above. Defendant must ensure that all of its employees attending a required training
21	sign a Training Verification form to verify attendance. A representative of the
22	organization providing the training (Instructor) must sign the Training Verification
23	form to verify each person listed on the form completed the training. Defendant mus
24	return all completed Training Verification forms to Complainant at the address on the
25	Form within 10 days of the date of the last training session and in no event later than
26	55 days following the date of the Commission's entry of an order in this docket.

1	E. ]	E. In the event that Complainant contends that Defendant has not complied with all of		
2	t	the terms of this Stipulation and all OUNC rules for that one-year period,		
3	(	Complainant may reopen this proceeding and petition for imposition of all or a		
4	1	portion of the suspended penalties. In such case, Defendant is entitled to a notice and		
5	1	hearing on the basis upon which Complainant contends that compliance has not		
6		occurred.		
7	F.	Complainant's failure to enforce any provision of this Stipulation, or decision to		
8	,	waive any violation or nonperformance of this Stipulation in one instance, will not		
9	(	constitute a waiver by the Complainant of that provision, any other provision, or any		
10	9	other violation or nonperformance in another instance.
