ORDER

DISPOSITION: ORDER NO. 17-345 AMENDED

This order memorializes our decision, made and effective at our September 26, 2017 Regular Public Meeting, to amend our prior conditional approval of PacifiCorp's 2017 Renewable Request for Proposals (RFP). We add one condition and four modifications.

We condition our decision to amend Order No. 17-345 on confirmation from the Oregon Independent Evaluator (IE) that it has resolved with PacifiCorp how to fairly score bids with different transmission requirements (i.e., Wyoming wind and non-Wyoming wind).

With the confirmation, we approve four modifications to the RFP to align our decision with that of the Utah Public Service Commission. These modifications are more specifically described in PacifiCorp's September 25, 2017 status update filed in this docket, and are summarized here as follows:


- Allow bids by non-Wyoming wind resources that can deliver to PacifiCorp;
- Add an additional PPA bid option;
- Clarify that bidders may provide comments on the pro forma agreements; and
- Clarify that the litigation clause excludes state commission complaints.


The remainder of the order is unchanged.
