ORDER

In the Matter of PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION OF OREGON, Investigation into PacifiCorp, dba Pacific Power's Oregon-Specific Cost Allocation Issues.

DISPOSITION: ORDER NO. 17-422 AMENDED

On October 18, 2017, the Oregon Citizens' Utility Board filed a Request for Payment of its PacifiCorp, dba Pacific Power Issue Fund Grant. In its request, CUB stated that its request was a final request and the remainder of the issue fund budget could be released back to the issue fund. On October 19, 2017, we issued Order No. 17-422 granting CUB's request and stating that the remainder of the issue fund budget should be released back to the issue fund.

On October 23, 2017, CUB filed a letter stating that its characterization of its request as a request for final payment was in error and that it will need to continue to access the funds in the approved proposed budget to continue its work. To allow CUB to continue to access the issue funds previously approved, we find it necessary to amend Order No. 17-422.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that Order No. 17-422 is amended as follows:

1. The second paragraph of the order is amended to read: CUB ask for a partial payment of \$2,635.94 from the PacifiCorp Issue Fund.

- 2. The last sentence of the paragraph immediately preceding the ordering paragraph (The balance of the approved budget should be made available to the PacifiCorp Issue Fund.) is deleted.
- 3. The remainder of Order No. 17-422 remains unchanged.
