ORDER

DISPOSITION: COMPLAINT DISMISSED; DOCKET CLOSED

On January 4, 2018, the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) issued a notice directing complainant to file, by January 12, 2018, a statement either withdrawing its complaint or requesting that a conference be convened to set a hearing date in this matter. If complainant were to fail to make a filing by January 12, the ALJ indicated that the Commission would assume complainant no longer intends to pursue this matter and will close the docket.

Complainant has failed to make any filing in response to the ALJ's ruling, and the time for doing so has expired. Since the complainant does not indicate an interest in pursuing this matter, the complaint should be dismissed and the docket closed.
