DISPOSITION: CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY CANCELED

On January 23, 2015, SS7 Networks, Inc. was granted a certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 15-014.

In a letter received September 30, 2019, Alfred R. Nurnberger, CTO for SS7 Networks, Inc., requested the Commission cancel the company's certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as it is no longer providing service in Oregon. The company is reminded that because it had a certificate of authority for one or more days in 2019, it is required to file a revenue statement and pay a minimum of \$100 for that year.

In view of the foregoing, the certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon held by SS7 Networks, Inc. should be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of authority held by SS7 Networks, Inc. is canceled.
