This notice is provided on behalf of PriorityOne Telecommunications, Inc. ("PriorityOne"). The undersigned is authorized to provide this notice on behalf of PriorityOne. PriorityOne is a "requesting carrier" under the Telecommunications Act of 1996 and was granted a service provider certificate of operating authority by the Oregon Public Utility Commission on January 31, 2000 in Docket Number CP 728, Order Number 00-044.

PriorityOne has decided to exercise the rights granted by Section 252(i) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996, as implemented by FCC rule, 47, C.F.R.
