**DISPOSITION: FURTHER PREHEARING CONFERENCE TO BE
SCHEDULED**

In my Ruling of November 3, 2003, I stated:

The issues remaining to be decided in this docket, as discussed above in Staff's correspondence, shall continue to be examined in the remainder of this proceeding. A further telephone prehearing conference shall be scheduled during the first two weeks in April, 2004, at a time to be mutually agreed upon by the parties. In the event that the parties are unable to agree and recommend such a time to the Commission, the Commission shall set the schedule unilaterally.

Pursuant to an agreement among the parties, a telephone prehearing conference was held on April 20, 2004. At the conference, it was agreed that the schedule of the proceeding should continue to be suspended and that a further prehearing conference should be held in June, 2004.

RULING

A further telephone prehearing conference shall be scheduled during the first two weeks in June, 2004, at a time to be mutually agreed upon by the parties. In the event that the parties are unable to agree and recommend such a time to the Commission, the Commission shall set the schedule unilaterally.
