23	recording of authorized	deferred expenses and insurance recoveries until the net		
24	Environmental Costs c	an be addressed in a future general rate case filing, in

1	matter. As the six sites are at different study and remediation stages, NW Natural may			
2	present to the Commission a proposed ratemaking treatment for deferred costs			
3	associated with a particular site, should costs and remediation at the particular site			
4	become known and certain. At the time of consideration for incorporation into rates,			
5	NW Natural will propose an appropriate amortization period for the Environmental			
6	Costs for the Commission's consideration. NW Natural does not request a			
7	determination of ratemaking treatment of the Environmental Costs at this time.			
8	4. An estimate of the amount to be recorded in the deferred accounts for the			
9	12-month period subsequent to the Application:			
10	The Company will incur additional site study, clean-up, potential natural			
11	resource damages, DEQ/Environment Protection Agency, tribe and natural resource			
12	damage trustee oversight, and legal costs as well as administrative expenses related to			
13	feasibility studies and remediation activities associated with these Sites. Environmental			
14	Costs will be charged to deferred regulatory asset accounts. Insurance recoveries will			
15	be used as offsets to deferred Environmental Costs. These anticipated expenses and			
16	recoveries from insurance are the cause of this filing. At this time, information is			
17	insufficient to more accurately estimate the total potential liability for investigation and			
18	remediation costs associated with the six sites, or to accurately estimate the			
19	corresponding total insurance recovery amounts.			
20	5. A description and explanation of the entries in the deferred accounts on			
21	the date of this Application for Reauthorization:			
22	NW Natural has recorded liabilities totaling \$6.5 million for the estimated			
23	costs of investigation and interim remediation at the Gasco site, including consultants'			
24	fees, and ODEQ oversight reimbursement and legal fees, of which \$5.1 million had			

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been spent as of December, 2005. NW Natural has recorded liabilities totaling \$0.6

- 1 million for its estimated costs of the investigation and initial remediation on the Wacker 2 (now known as Siltronic) site and has paid expenses totaling \$0.6 million as of 3 December 2005. NW Natural has recorded liabilities totaling \$6.4 million as of 4 December, 2005 for its estimated remedial investigation costs on the Portland Harbor 5 site of which \$4.2 million had been spent as of December, 2005. NW Natural has 6 recorded liabilities totaling \$0.2 million as of December, 2005 for its estimated remedial 7 investigation costs on the Oregon Steel Mills site of which \$21 thousand had been 8 spent as of December, 2005. Finally, NW Natural has recorded liabilities totaling \$10.0 9 million as of December, 2005 for its estimated investigation and remediation costs on 10 Tar Body of which \$7.2 million had been spent as of December, 2005. 11 6. As part of this reauthorization application, the company seeks to begin 12 accruing interest to the deferred balances. As of the date of this application, the 13 company has spent over \$17 million on projects. As those amounts continue to be 14 outstanding in anticipation of insurance offsets or recovery from ratepayers, there is an 15 ongoing burden of financing the spent amounts. As insurance proceeds are attained, 16 they will be used to draw down the amounts outstanding, until final ratemaking is 17 determined for the deferred accounts, and interest on the balance would be affected 18 accordingly. 19 7. The continuation of deferred accounting for the matters addressed above
- 7. The continuation of deferred accounting for the matters addressed above20 is justified because they are continuing in nature.
