Northwest Industrial Gas Users Request for Payment of 2004 Preauthorized Matching Grant, NW Natural Account, Docket Nos. UM 1147, UP 205/UM 1148, UG 152, PGA, Pipeline Integrity and Storage Issues

## Honorable Judge Grant:

The Northwest Industrial Gas Users ("NWIGU") files this request for payment of a 2004 Preauthorized Matching Grant from NW Natural's Preauthorized Matching Fund Account in the amount of \$4,358.05. This request for payment is filed pursuant to Section 7.2 of the Intervenor Funding Agreement ("IFA"), which was approved by the Oregon Public Utility Commission ("OPUC") on July 2, 2003, in Order No. 03-388. The Commission's rules provide that the terms of a Commission-approved intervenor funding agreement will be binding on all organizations seeking a grant under the agreement and will be followed by the Commission in administering the agreement. OAR 860-012-0100(2).

NWIGU meets all of the criteria for payment of a Preauthorized Matching Grant from the NW Natural Preauthorized Matching Fund Account, as demonstrated by the following:

1. Under the IFA, NW Natural makes available an Annual Grant Amount of \$50,000, which is added to NW Natural's Preauthorized Matching Fund Account each calendar year during the term of the IFA. IFA at Section 4.2.2.

2. This is NWIGU's first Request for Payment for a Preauthorized Matching Grant for Eligible Expenses in 2004. NWIGU received Commission approval in Order No. 04-055 issued February 3, 2004 for \$50,000 from the 2003 NW Natural Matching Fund, but has not previously filed any other Request for Payment from the 2004 NW Natural Matching Fund. The current NW Natural Preauthorized Matching Fund balance is \$100,000 in 2007 (\$50,000 from the current year and \$50,000 in rollover funds). NWIGU may file a Request for Payment for a Preauthorized Matching Grant at any time during the term of the IFA. IFA at Section 7.2. The current IFA does not expire until December 31, 2007, with the First Amended and Restated Intervenor Funding Agreement becoming effective on January 1, 2008 under Order No. 07-564 until December 31, 2012. Funds from NW Natural's Preauthorized Matching Fund Account are available for use

exclusively by NWIGU, IFA at Section 4.2.2.

- 3. A Preauthorized Matching Grant from NW Natural must be used solely to pay Eligible Expenses for Eligible Proceedings involving NW Natural. IFA at Section 4.2.2. NWIGU requests the payment of a Preauthorized Matching Grant for Eligible Expenses incurred in calendar year 2004 in the following Eligible Proceedings in 2004: Docket Nos. UM 1147 deferred accounting, UP 205/UM 1148 Fish Block properties, UG 152 Coos Bay, PGA, Pipeline Integrity tracker, Hedging and Storage Issues. NWIGU requests the payment of the \$4,358.05 Preauthorized Matching Grant for the expenses listed in Exhibit A, attached, which are Eligible Expenses under Section 7.4 of the IFA. These expenses are in excess of any amounts recovered through Issue Fund Grants and/or other Matching Fund Grant Requests.
- 4. A Preauthorized Matching Grant may be provided only if NWIGU demonstrates that it has used in-house resources or outside funding for at least 50% of the Eligible Expenses for Eligible Proceedings. IFA at Section 7.2. As shown in Exhibit A, NWIGU has used in-house resources and outside funding for at least 50% of the Eligible Expenses in each of these proceedings.
- 5. Section 4.2.2 of the IFA requires that NWIGU become precertified (in accordance with Section 5.2 of the IFA) within one year of the effective date of the IFA in order to be eligible to receive a Preauthorized Matching Grant. NWIGU became precertified as eligible to receive intervenor funding grants under Section 5.2 of the IFA pursuant to Order No.04-055, entered by the Commission on February 3, 2004.
- 6. The following summarizes the Requests for Payment for a NW Natural Preauthorized Matching Grant, which have been received by NWIGU or are pending for Commission approval during the IFA:

- a. \$50,000 from the NW Natural 2003 Preauthorized Matching Fund (approved Order No. 04-055);
- b. \$4,358.05 pending Request for 2004 NW Natural Preauthorized Matching Fund;
- c. \$6,069.09 pending Request for 2005 NW Natural Preauthorized Matching Fund;
- d. \$8,902.54 pending Request for 2006 NW Natural Preauthorized Matching Fund; and,
- e. \$5,589.85 pending Request for 2007 NW Natural Preauthorized Matching Fund for Jan.-Oct. 2007.

Having demonstrated that it meets all of the criteria and conditions for such request, NWIGU requests payment of a Preauthorized Matching Grant from NW Natural's Preauthorized Matching Fund in the amount of \$4,358.05 for 2004 Eligible Expenses. NWIGU requests that the Commission grant this request within 30 days of receipt and order NW Natural to pay NWIGU the amount of \$4,358.05 within 30 days after receipt of the Commission directive, in accordance with Section 7.2 of the IFA.
