DISPOSITION: PETITION TO INTERVENE GRANTED

On March 26, 2004, Qwest Corporation (Qwest) filed a Petition to Intervene (Petition), asserting that it is the largest local incumbent provider of telecommunications services in the State of Oregon, has competitive provider and wireless affiliates and, like AT&T, has certificates of authority in Oregon. Qwest asserts that it has an interest in seeing that this proceeding “is conducted and resolved in a reasonable, competitively neutral and nondiscriminatory manner.”¹

Qwest further asserts that it intends to address or comment on various issues and has knowledge and experience that will assist the Commission in addressing the issues presented in this proceeding and that its appearance and participation will not unreasonably broaden the issues, burden the record or unreasonably delay this proceeding.² No objections were interposed to the Petition.

RULING

Good cause having been shown, the Petition to Intervene filed by Qwest Corporation. is granted.
