**DISPOSITION: INTERVENTION GRANTED; COMMENT SCHEDULE
ADOPTED; REQUEST FOR ISSUANCE OF SUBPOENA
DENIED**

On September 7, 2005, a telephone prehearing conference was held in this docket. The Petition to Intervene filed by XO Communications Services, Inc., was granted. Eschelon Telecom of Oregon, Inc.; Qwest Corporation (Qwest); Integra Telecom of Oregon, Inc.; the Telecommunications Ratepayers Association for Cost-Based and Equitable Rates; Time-Warner Telecom of Oregon, LLC; PriorityOne Telecommunications, Inc.; Rio Communications, Inc.; Eastern Oregon Telecom, Inc.; and the Commission staff (Staff) entered appearances in the case.

The Parties discussed Qwest's request for disaggregated CLEC facilities-provisioned customer line data from the Final Competitive Local Exchange Carrier (CLEC) Survey Report (Report), and Staff's objections thereto. CLECs on the call indicated their concerns regarding the sharing of disaggregated data.

The parties agreed to, and the Administrative Law Judge adopted, the following schedule while holding in abeyance a ruling on the disaggregation:

The Administrative Law Judge denied the Qwest request to issue a subpoena to CLEC "K."
