DISPOSITION: MOTION DENIED

On November 15, 2005, Portland General Electric Company (PGE) supplemented its application for authorization to issue new common stock. It noted that it had provided the supplements to other parties in the docket prior to the close of the record, but had not submitted them to the Commission in a timely fashion. It also requested an expedited time for response to its motion, to November 22, allowing seven days for a response.

OAR 860-013-0050(3)(d) allows 15 days for a response to a motion. PGE's previous motion for an expedited response fit the schedule at that time and allowed for a coordinated response by the parties. *See* Motion at 2 (Sept 1, 2005). There is no such efficiency present in this situation. Given PGE's delay in introducing this matter more than one month after the close of the record, other parties should have the full time to respond to the motion.

The motion is denied.
