9	PacifiCorp states:		
10	The Commission's rules author	rize PacifiCorp to seek reasonable restrictions	
11	on discovery of trade secrets and other confidential business information. See OAR 860-1		
12	0000(3) (adopting Oregon Rules of Civil Procedure ("ORCP")); ORCP 36(C)(7) (providing		
13	protection against unrestricted discovery of "tr	ade secrets or other confidential research,	
14	development, or commercial information"). Se	ee also In re Investigation into the Cost of	
15	Providing Telecommunication Service (UM 351), Order No. 91-500 (1991) (recognizing that		
16	protective orders are a reasonable means to protect "the rights of a party to trade secrets		
17	and other confidential commercial information" and "to facilitate the communication of		
18	information between litigants").		
19	2. PacifiCorp anticipates that disc	overy in this proceeding may include	
20	proprietary cost data and models, commercially sensitive load and resource projections,		
21	RFP-related information covered by confidentiality agreements, confidential market		
22	analyses, and confidential information regarding contracts for the purchase or sale of		
23	electric power, power services, or fuel. PacifiCorp will be exposed to competitive injury if it		
24	is forced to make unrestricted disclosure of its confidential business information.

1	3. Pacificorp has asked the Commission to expedite review of its filing in this	
2	case. Issuance of a protective order will facilitate the production of relevant information, aid	
3	the discovery process and expedite resolution of this case.	
4	For the foregoing reasons, Pacific	Corp requests entry of the Commission's standard
5	protective order in this docket.
