RULING

DISPOSITION: *PRO HAC VICE* MOTION GRANTED; SCHEDULE  
SUSPENDED

On January 6, 2006, Charter Communications Holding Company, LLC (Charter Communications), moved to admit T. Scott Thompson as counsel *pro hac vice*. Mr. Thompson, a member in good standing in the District of Columbia, filed the appropriate affidavit, certificate of good standing, and proof of insurance. The motion and related filings satisfy the requirements of Oregon Uniform Trial Court Rule 3.170, and no objections have been received. The motion is granted.

On January 23, 2006, Central Lincoln People's Utility District (CLPUD) moved for an extension of time to respond to Charter Communications' motion for emergency injunctive relief. The motion stated that the parties have conferred and that an agreement is anticipated. If no such agreement is reached, CLPUD will reply by January 27, 2006.
