IDAHO POWER COMPANY'S MOTION

Staff's request to open an investigation
regarding performance-based ratemaking
mechanisms to address potential build-vs-
buy bias

In the Prehearing Conference Report dated October 2, 2006, Administrative Law Judge Traci Kirkpatrick (the "ALJ") adopted a schedule in this case including a Workshop set for December 4, 2006. In a subsequent Memorandum dated November 20, 2006, the Workshop date was extended at the request of Northwest Independent Power Producers, to January 22, 2007, in order to allow the parties additional time to discuss issues and find common positions.

Idaho Power Company ("Idaho Power"), along with Staff and several of the other intervenors, believe that the parties will benefit from additional time to continue to work together on the issues raised by this important policy docket. For that reason Idaho Power requests that the Workshop currently scheduled for January 22, 2007 be moved to February 21, 2007.

Staff has notified all parties of Idaho Power's intention to file this motion to modify the schedule and none of the parties have objected.


