RULING

DISPOSITION: MOTION TO ADMIT COUNSEL *PRO HAC VICE* GRANTED

On April 26, 2024, the Oregon Citizens' Utility Board filed a motion to allow Claire Valentine-Fossum to appear as counsel *pro hac vice* in this proceeding. The statement of Ms. Valentine-Fossum accompanied the motion. Ms. Valentine-Fossum filed a supplement to the motion on May 16, 2024. Ms. Valentine-Fossum states that she will associate with Jennifer Hill-Hart, an active member in good standing with the Oregon State Bar.

I have reviewed the motion for admission *pro hac vice* and find that it complies with the requirements of UTCR 3.170 and OAR 860-001-0320. No objections have been received.

The motion to admit Claire Valentine-Fossum as counsel *pro hac vice* on behalf of the Oregon Citizens' Utility Board is granted for a one-year period. For cases continuing over one year, an attorney appearing *pro hac vice* must file a new application to continue to participate in the case.¹
