3. ICNU is an incorporated, non-profit association of large industrial electric customers in the Pacific Northwest, with offices in Portland, Oregon. A list of ICNU members is included as Attachment A. Many members of ICNU are customers of Portland General Electric Company (“PGE” or the “Company”) as indicated on Attachment A.

4. ICNU has a substantial interest in the outcome of this proceeding. ICNU represents the interests of many of PGE’s largest customers that may be affected by the transfer of property associated with the Bull Run project to Western Rivers Conservancy. The Commission’s decision in this proceeding could have a substantial impact on the rates for service that PGE provides to ICNU’s members.

5. ICNU has participated in many proceedings before the Commission involving PGE. ICNU’s intervention in this proceeding will assist the Commission in resolving the issues, and will not unreasonably burden the record, delay the proceedings, or broaden the issues.

6. As described above, ICNU has a direct and substantial interest in this proceeding that will not be adequately represented by any other party, and may be affected by any Commission determination made in connection with the Application. It is in the public interest to allow ICNU to intervene in this proceeding.
