RE: Sherwood School District request for 2,000 sequential DID numbers.

Dear Mr. Birko,

On December 15, 2006, Verizon received a request from Dan Jamison, Superintendent for the Sherwood School District, for 2,000 sequential DID numbers. Sherwood school district will be expanding to add a new elementary school, a new middle school and an addition to the existing high school. They plan to realign the District's telephone numbering scheme in the next six to eighteen months. Verizon does not have 2,000 consecutive numbers available to meet Sherwood's request.

On February 1, 2007 Verizon submitted a Part1A application to Neustar for two (2) 1,000 blocks. The request was denied by Neustar because it didn't meet months to exhaust requirements. The Sherwood rate center is at 42.7 months to exhaust. Federal Communications Commission Order (FCC) No. FCC 01-362, Part IV, Paragraphs 47 through 66 grants state commissions the authority to grant waivers of numbering conservation requirements to meet a unique and specific customer request. Since the Sherwood School District's request for 2,000 sequential DID numbers is a unique request that Verizon is unable to meet, we respectfully request that the Commission grant a waiver from the months to exhaust criterion so that Verizon may respond to its customer's needs.

Re: Request for Sequential DID Telephone Numbers

Sir/Madam:

With the successful passing of our bond measure, Sherwood School District is now moving forward with the construction of a new elementary school, a new middle school, and a substantial remodel and addition to our high school. These additional schools have put us in the position of needing to realign our entire District's telephone numbering scheme.

Our District will require two thousand (2,000) sequential DID numbers to complete this realignment on our existing PRI and it's our understanding that there are not two thousand sequential DID numbers with the prefix of "625" or "925" available. In addition, as part of our dialing restrictions, we can not use the zero or nine block.

We anticipate these DID numbers will be put in service within the next six to eighteen months. Two thousand DID numbers would meet our District's dialing needs for the next five years.

Once these new DID numbers are made available and our numbering realignment is complete, we plan to leave our existing main District telephone numbers in place for one school year to ease the transition for parents, community members, patrons and staff. After that time, we will return our current blocks of DID numbers to Verizon.

**Thousands-Block Application Form** **Part1A****Instructions for filling out each Section of the Part 1A form:**

Section 1.1 Contact information requires that Service Providers supply under “Block Applicant” the company name, company headquarters address, a contact within the company, an address where the contact person may be reached, in addition to the correct phone, fax, and e-mail address. The Pooling Administrator section also requires the Service Provider to fill in the Pooling Administrator’s name, address, phone, fax and e-mail.

Section 1.2 Service Providers who need a thousands-block assignment or for an Location Routing Number (LRN) are required to fill in this section. If needed for an LRN, a CO Code Application needs to also be submitted to the PA. The Service Provider should supply the Numbering Plan Area (NPA); the Local Access Transport Area (LATA), which is a three-digit number that can be found in the Telcordia™ LERG™ Routing Guide. The Operating Company Number (OCN) assigned to the service provider and the OCN its parent company. An OCN is a four-character alphanumeric assigned by Telcordia™ Routing Administration (TRA). In addition, the number of thousands-blocks requested should be supplied. The Switch Identification as well as the city or wire center name, rate center, rate center sub zone, homing tandem and CLLI™ tandem of the facilities based provider. Explanations of these terms may be found in the footnotes.

Section 1.3 The date the Service Provider completes the application should be entered in this section, as well as the Effective Date of the requested thousands-block.

Section 1.4 Service Providers should indicate their type, e.g., local exchange carrier, competitive local exchange carrier, interexchange carrier, CMRS. They also indicate the primary type of business in which the numbering resource is to be used. Service Providers also may indicate their preference for a particular thousands-block, e.g., 321-9XXX, or indicate any thousands-blocks that may be undesirable, e.g., 321-6XXX.

Section 1.5 Service Providers indicate the type of request. Initial requests are for first applications for thousands-blocks in a rate center, growth for additional thousands-blocks in a rate center in which the applicant already has numbering resources, and provide the required evidence as ordered by the FCC.

The thousands-block applicant certifies veracity of this form by signing their name, and providing their title and date.
