**DISPOSITION: MOTION TO SUSPEND PROCEDURAL
SCHEDULE GRANTED**

On October 10, 2007, Staff for the Public Utility Commission of Oregon filed a Motion to Suspend Procedural Schedule in this docket. Staff requests that the schedule be suspended to allow the parties time to consider whether to file joint comments regarding the standards under consideration. Staff indicates that it was able to contact all of the parties except PacifiCorp regarding the suspension and no party objected. Staff stated that the parties will decide whether to file joint comments by the status conference scheduled for October 15, 2007, and a new procedural schedule can be established at that time.

Staff's motion to suspend the procedural schedule is granted. Staff should prepare and distribute a proposed procedural schedule to be discussed at the October 15 status conference.
