### **APPLICATION**

1	PacifiCorp, d.b.a. Pacific Power ("Pacific Power" or "Company"), files this
2	Application for Allocation of Exclusive Service Territory ("Application") pursuant to
3	ORS 758.435 and OAR 860-025-0020 for approval from the Public Utility Commission of
4	Oregon ("Commission").
5	In support of this Application, the Company states as follows:
6	I. Introduction
7	PacifiCorp is an electric public utility subject to the Commission's jurisdiction.
8	PacifiCorp provides retail electric service to customers in California, Idaho, Oregon, Utah,
9	Washington and Wyoming. In Oregon, the Company provides retail electric service within a
10	defined service territory approved by the Commission. The Company also provides retail
11	electric service to portions of Sherman County, Oregon, which are not currently allocated to
12	any electric utility. With this Application, the Company seeks to exclusively provide retail
13	electric utility service to those areas in Sherman County. For purposes of this Application,
14	the Company will refer to the requested allocated territory as "Hay Canyon."

- 12 IV. Application Requirements under OAR 860-025-0020
- 13 A. Map of PacifiCorp's Oregon Service Area
- Maps depicting the general location and boundaries of the Company's Oregon service
- 15 territories are on file with the Commission, and there have been no material changes since
- 16 that filing. Additionally, the maps are large and cumbersome. For these reasons, the
- 17 Company respectfully requests a waiver of this filing requirement.
- 18 B. Map Showing Location of Customers and Facilities in Territory For Which
- 19 **Applied**
- A map depicting the location of Pacific Power's customers and facilities in the
- 21 territory that is the subject of this Application is attached as Attachment A-1. A map
- 22 depicting the Company's existing service territory boundaries and new service territory

- boundaries is included as Attachment A-2. A map depicting the towns around the Hay
- 2 Canyon area is Attachment A-3.

### 3 C. Description of Exclusive Service Area

- 4 A metes and bounds description of the territory being requested for allocation to
- 5 Pacific Power is attached as Attachment B-1 and B-2. Attachment B-1 contains a redlined
- 6 version of the current metes and bounds description to show the revisions necessary to
- 7 achieve the requested service territory allocation. Attachment B-2 contains a clean metes and
- 8 bounds description for the requested service territory allocation.
- 9 D. Facts Showing PacifiCorp is Lawfully and in Good Faith Providing Exclusive
- 10 Electric Utility Service within the Described Area and that no Other Person is
- 11 Providing A Similar Utility Service Within the Described Area
- The Hay Canyon territory is comprised of approximately 10 square miles of largely
- 13 rural terrain. Pacific Power currently provides residential and/or agricultural electric service
- 14 to four customers in the Hay Canyon territory. Additionally, Pacific Power is installing a V-
- 15 Phase line to provide service to portions of a 17-turbine wind generation farm being
- 16 constructed by Iberdrola Renewables in the Hay Canyon area. The Company has obtained the
- 17 necessary easements to operate its facilities in the Hay Canyon area. Also, the Company
- 18 entered into a franchise agreement with the City of Wasco, which is located in the Hay
- 19 Canyon area.
- Two other retail electric service providers, Wasco Electric Cooperative, Inc.
- 21 ("Wasco") and Columbia Basin Electric Cooperative, Inc ("Columbia Basin") hold service
- 22 territory either immediately adjacent or in proximity to the Hay Canyon area. Portions of
- Wasco's service territory abut the Hay Canyon area and several of Wasco's distribution lines
- 24 cross to the north and south of the Hay Canyon area. However, Wasco does not currently

- serve any customers within the Hay Canyon area. The Commission's order allocating service
- 2 territory to Wasco specifically excluded the Hay Canyon area. Columbia Basin's service
- 3 territory is in proximity to the Hay Canyon area. Additionally, the Bonneville Power
- 4 Authority ("BPA") provides transmission service in the Hay Canyon area and Wasco's
- 5 immediately adjacent service territory. However, neither Columbia Basin nor BPA provide
- 6 retail electric service to customers in the Hay Canyon area.
- 7 Pacific Power is the only retail electric service supplier providing service in the Hay
- 8 Canyon area and is currently expanding its facilities to accommodate other customers in the
- 9 area. The Company has obtained the necessary property rights and has entered into service
- 10 agreements to provide service within the Hay Canyon area. Pacific Power is in the best
- position to provide exclusive electric service to the Hay Canyon area. Pacific Power has
- 12 contacted both Wasco and Columbia Basin about this matter and is not aware objections to
- 13 this Application.

#### E. Additional Information

- Pacific Power is not aware of anything that would impede its ability to provide
- 16 electric service to the Hay Canyon area. In addition to the information provided above, the
- 17 Company is not aware of any legal actions or disputes that would impede the Company's
- ability to provide service to the Hay Canyon area.
- 19 For all of these reasons, it is appropriate to grant authority to Pacific Power to provide
- 20 exclusive electric service to the Hay Canyon area.
- 21 WHEREFORE, PacifiCorp respectfully requests an order approving this Application
- 22 for Allocation of Exclusive Service Territory.


