Bench Request 1

When PacifiCorp, dba Pacific Power (Pacific Power) filed its initial application in this docket, it also provided Highly Confidential work papers to Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission) and parties that signed Special Protective Order No. 10-148. However, the work papers were not submitted as an exhibit for inclusion in the record. To assist the Commission with its review of this matter, Pacific Power is directed to file these work papers, both on CD and in hard copy format, thereby making them part of the evidentiary record in this proceeding.
