3. If the petitioner is an organization, the number of members in and the purposes of the organization:

WaterWatch is a non-profit 501(c)(3) river conservation group devoted to restoring and protecting natural flows in Oregon's rivers. Incorporated in 1985, WaterWatch has a membership of approximately 1,000 and remains the only Oregon conservation organization devoted exclusively to restoring and protecting flows in our rivers and streams. WaterWatch works across Oregon, including in the Klamath Basin, to protect streamflows and the public interest in the development and implementation of water policy and statute at the state and federal level, and by protecting Oregon's waterways through administrative and judicial proceedings.

4.. The nature and extent of the Petitioner's interest in the proceeding is:

WaterWatch is a party to the relicensing of PacifiCorp's Klamath Hydroelectric Project P-2082 before the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission and has participated in various processes and negotiations related to that proceeding. WaterWatch lobbied on and testified at the Oregon legislature regarding SB 76, which gives rise to this proceeding, and has participated in other OPUC rate cases (UE-170 and UE 171) related to PacifiCorp's operations in the Klamath Basin. Lastly, WaterWatch has over a decade of experience working on water issues relating to the Klamath River including those associated with PacifiCorp's facilities.

5. The issues the Petitioner intends to raise at the proceeding are:

WaterWatch intends to raise issues related to whether the surcharge is just, fair and reasonable; whether the surcharge is designed to adequately and equitably

implement the relevant goals; whether the surcharge is in the public interest; and whether the depreciation rate for the Klamath dams is determined appropriately.

6. The special knowledge or expertise of the Petitioner that would assist the Commission in resolving the issues in the proceeding is:

WaterWatch has knowledge of Oregon (and California) electric rate issues regarding PacifiCorp's Klamath Hydroelectric Project and has participated in two OPUC rate cases (UE-170 and UE-171) addressing PacifiCorp electric rates in the Klamath Basin. WaterWatch is knowledgeable and has expertise in Oregon's licensing and water permitting process for hydroelectric projects; and a strong familiarity with PacifiCorp's Klamath Hydroelectric Project.

7. Based on the information provided above in accordance with the Commission's rules of procedure, I request to participate in this proceeding as an intervenor. I or the organization that I represent will not unreasonably broaden the issues, burden the record, or unreasonably delay the proceeding. OAR 860-012-0001.


