The Klamath Tribes are a federally recognized Indian tribe with a government-to-government relationship with the United States and the State of Oregon. The Tribes have about 3,600 members.

4.. The nature and extent of the Petitioner's interest in the proceeding is:

The Tribes are a party to the Klamath Hydroelectric Settlement Agreement (KHSAs). The Tribes, through the KHSAs and otherwise, support the KHSAs's goal of removing dams from the Klamath River. This proceeding is consistent with that goal of the KHSAs and is, in fact, a part of the process of pursuing that goal. As a party to the KHSAs the Tribes are committed to supporting the surcharge under consideration here. The Tribes are also interested in reviewing PacifiCorp's economic analysis supporting the surcharge.

5. The issues the Petitioner intends to raise at the proceeding are:


The Tribes intend to support the surcharge as being fair, just and reasonable.

6. The special knowledge or expertise of the Petitioner that would assist the Commission in resolving the issues in the proceeding is:

The Tribes manage fisheries, water and other resources in the Klamath Basin. The Tribes have been in the Basin and have depended on and managed these resources for more than 14,000 years, so they have a significant background of knowledge and experience regarding Basin resources. In addition, they have a

modern professional staff with expertise in the fields of fisheries, water quality, hydrology, and geomorphology.

7. Based on the information provided above in accordance with the Commission's rules of procedure, I request to participate in this proceeding as an intervenor.
