EXPEDITED CONSIDERATION REQUESTED


8 The Public Utility Commission of Oregon Staff (Staff) and Fish Mills Lodges Water
9 System (Company) are continuing to have good faith settlement discussions. To avoid additional
10 litigation costs and pursue a possible settlement, Staff respectfully requests that this schedule be
11 held in abeyance for up to 45 days. If the parties are unable to reach a settlement, Staff agrees to
12 contact the Administrative Law Judge to ask for a prehearing conference to establish a new
13 schedule.

14 Counsel for Staff has spoken to counsel for the Company and the Company supports this
15 motion. The Parties request and support expedited consideration in order to save the Company
16 the expense of filing testimony on March 9, 2011, and, instead, focus on settlement.
