
DISPOSITION: MOTION TO ADMIT *PRO HAC VICE* GRANTED

On December 20, 2013, i-wireless, LLC, filed a motion to renew Lance J. M. Steinhart's status to appear as counsel *pro hac vice* in this proceeding. The previous motion for *pro hac vice* was granted by my Ruling of December 13, 2012.

OAR 860-001-0320(3) provides that "[E]ach application is good for one attorney for a single case for one year." Accordingly i-wireless filed the motion so Mr. Steinhart could continue to participate as counsel in this docket. The Affidavit of Mr. Steinhart accompanies the motion and Mr. Steinhart states that he will associate with Mark P. Trincherro and Alan Galloway, active members in good standing with the Oregon State Bar.

I have reviewed the motion and find that it complies with the requirements of UTCR 3.170 and OAR 860-001-0320. No objections have been received. The motion to admit Lance J. M. Steinhart counsel *pro hac vice* is granted.
