MEMORANDUM

DISPOSITION: SCHEDULE ESTABLISHED

On February 23, 2011, the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission) held a prehearing conference in this docket. Representatives appeared on behalf of Portland General Electric Company (PGE); Commission Staff, the Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities (ICNU); RTP Controls, and the Citizens' Utility Board of Oregon (CUB).

Parties

Prior to the prehearing conference, ICNU filed a petition to intervene. No party appearing at the conference objected to ICNU's petition. ICNU's petition shows that ICNU has sufficient interest in the proceeding to participate and that its appearance and participation will not unreasonably broaden the issues, burden the record, or delay the proceeding.¹ The petition is therefore granted.

On January 12, 2011, CUB filed a Notice of Intervention under ORS 774.180 and became a party to the proceeding.
