**Re: UE 231 - Steam Sale Agreement between PGE and Columbia River Processing
Advice Filing 2016-S4 (Extension Request through 3-31-17)**

Per ORS 757.005, 757.007, and 757.009, enclosed for filing is a **second** Amendment to the Steam Sale Agreement between Portland General Electric Company (PGE) and Columbia River Processing (Columbia).

PGE filed Advice 2016 S-1 on or about July 7, 2016 requesting an extension of the expiration date of the Steam Sale Agreement to December 31, 2016, and received approval through OPUC Order 16-271 dated July 19, 2016. PGE is now requesting an additional extension of the expiration date to March 31, 2017. The additional delay has resulted from a request from ConAgra - one of PGE's other steam customers in Morrow County. ConAgra is currently undergoing a corporate reorganization and has indicated that its contract team will be very busy in the next few months working on the reorganization. As a result, ConAgra has requested that the execution of its new Steam Sale Agreement be delayed and expects to be able to complete negotiation of the Steam Sale Agreement by the end of the first quarter of 2017.

Accordingly, in order to keep the terms of all steam sale agreements aligned, PGE is requesting that the expiration date of the Steam Sale Agreement with Columbia be extended from December 31, 2016 to March 31, 2017.


PGE has filed similar extension requests for: 1) the ConAgra agreement (Advice 2016-S3, UE-243) and 2) the Boardman Foods, Inc. (Advice 2016-S5, UE 238);

PGE asks that the Public Utility Commission of Oregon ("OPUC") consider this extension at the December 6th public meeting. PGE will file all of the new agreements with the OPUC for its

review at the close of negotiations, and anticipates that it will request that these agreements become effective on April 1, 2017.

AMENDMENT TO STEAM SALE AGREEMENT

THIS AMENDMENT TO STEAM SALE AGREEMENT (this "Amendment") is made and effective as of this 21st day of October 2016 ("Effective Date"), by and between Portland General Electric Company ("PGE") and Columbia River Processing, Inc. ("Columbia"). PGE and Columbia are sometimes referred to in this Amendment in the singular as "Party" and in the plural as the "Parties."

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, PGE and Columbia have heretofore entered into that certain Steam Sale Agreement effective August 1, 2011 (the "Agreement") pursuant to which PGE agreed to sell steam to Columbia and Columbia agreed to purchase steam from PGE for the purpose of using steam for Columbia's industrial operations.

WHEREAS, pursuant to an Amendment to Steam Sale Agreement effective May 9, 2016, the Parties agreed to extend the expiration date of the Agreement to December 31, 2016.

WHEREAS, PGE and Columbia now wish to extend the expiration date of the Agreement from December 31, 2016 to March 31, 2017, and to enter into negotiations for a new Steam Sale Agreement to become effective April 1, 2017.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Parties hereby agree that the Agreement be amended as follows:

1. All capitalized terms used in this Amendment, to the extent not otherwise expressly defined herein, shall have the same meanings ascribed to such terms in the Agreement
2. As of the Effective Date of this Amendment, the Agreement is hereby amended to extend the expiration date of the Term from December 31, 2016 to March 31, 2017.
3. Except as provided herein, the terms and conditions of the Agreement shall be unmodified and shall continue in full force and effect. To the extent, if any, that the terms and conditions of this Amendment conflict with the terms and conditions of the Agreement, the Agreement is amended accordingly, and the terms and conditions of this Amendment shall control.
4. Each Party represents that it has the full legal right, power and authority to enter into this Amendment and that this Amendment shall constitute a valid and legally binding obligation of such Party enforceable against such Party in accordance with its terms.
5. This Amendment may be executed in one (1) or more counterparts, each of which when taken together shall constitute one and the same Amendment. Counterparts bearing facsimile signatures shall be deemed to constitute originals.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Parties have caused this Agreement to be executed by their duly authorized officers as of the Effective Date.
