Re: PGE 2022 Notice of Promotional Concession; Electric Tool Exchange Events

This letter serves to advise of Portland General Electric Company's (PGE) planned Promotional Concession of two Electric Tool Exchange Events submitted pursuant to Oregon Administrative Rules (OARs) 860-026-0015 and 860-026-0025. The Electric Tool Exchange Event allows Customers who register in advance to recycle gasoline-powered lawn mowers, chainsaws, leaf blowers, and/or trimmers and purchase new electric lawn mowers, chainsaws, leaf blowers, and/or trimmers. For each purchased tool, Customers will receive a \$100 discount on an electric mower and/or a \$50 discount for each electric chainsaw, leaf blower, or trimmer purchased. PGE is partnering with EGO Tools and Ewing Irrigation with these events.

While this Promotional Concession is expected to slightly increase electric load for participating customers, offering this Promotional Concession benefits Customers wanting to decarbonize their energy footprint through the electrification of their landscaping tools.

The Electric Tool Exchange Events are scheduled for late April 2022, but may be rescheduled if needed due to inclement weather. PGE has partnered with the cities of Lake Oswego, Wilsonville, and West Linn to offer Clackamas County Events around Earth Day. The event aligns with the City of Lake Oswego's Sustainability Resource Fair and Wilsonville's Environmental Resource Keepers Day. These Events are being publicized via the City of Lake Oswego's, City of Wilsonville's, and City of West Linn's social media, neighborhood newsletters, neighborhood association pages, and each city's website.

PGE has planned two other Electric Tool Exchange Events later in the year with the City of Milwaukie in September and at the Portland Home & Garden Show in October. The events will be publicized via social media, emails, and in coordination with the Home & Garden Show's marketing.

PGE anticipates providing \$13,000 in Customer rebates for the two April Electric Tool Exchange Events. These amounts are paid for by PGE Shareholders.
