Re: RE 46 PGE 2024 Notice of Green Future Promotional Concession

This letter serves to advise of Portland General Electric Company's (PGE) planned Promotional Concession to increase participant engagement and retention in the Green Future Choice and/or Green Future Block (Renewable Fixed and Renewable Usage options described in Schedules 7 and 32) pursuant to Oregon Administrative Rules (OARs) 860-026-0015 and 860-026-0025.

PGE intends to offer promotional concessions that align with Green Future's focus on sustainability to encourage residential participants in Green Future to support businesses enrolled in Green Future, in celebration of Green Future's 25th anniversary. Residential participants who visit at least two Green Future businesses between July 1 and August 31 will be entered into a drawing to win one of five gift packages valued at \$100 or less. Examples of the promotional concessions included in the gift package include, but are not limited to, gift cards to a Green Future business and 25th anniversary-branded beverage containers. To be eligible to win, a customer will need to: 1) be an existing PGE residential customer, 2) visit at least two Green Future businesses between July 1 and August 31, and 3) submit an online form attesting the visits to PGE or enter via mail by August 31. Customers will not be required to make purchases at the Green Future businesses they visit to be eligible to win. Limit one entry per person.

This 25th anniversary business support challenge will be publicized to Green Future participants via a bill insert for paper bill customers and via two separate emails for paperless customers. When offered through a paper or digital channel, messaging may be accompanied by an image of the promotional items to attract the attention of customers. For example, the Company may include a promotional message with an email message which may read as follows:

"Visit any two Green Future businesses between July 1 and August 31 and be eligible to win a free gift package, featuring a gift card to a Green Future business and an exclusive 25th Anniversary Green Future HydroFlask."

PGE has a competitive RFP for marketing and outreach services and the additional costs of offering the promotional concessions described here are included in the costs already paid to PGE's selected marketing and outreach partner through 2024.
