DISPOSITION: JOINT MOTION TO SUSPEND THE PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE GRANTED

On June 28, 2013, PacifiCorp, dba Pacific Power filed a joint motion to suspend the procedural schedule in this docket, on behalf of the following parties: Pacific Power; Commission Staff; the Citizens' Utility Board of Oregon; the Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities, Fred Meyer Stores and Quality Food Centers, divisions of the Kroger Co.; Wal-Mart Stores, Inc.; and Noble Americas Energy Solutions (collectively, the Settling Parties). Counsel for Pacific Power states that the Settling Parties have reached a comprehensive settlement in principle on all contested issues, and that the Settling Parties do not anticipate that any other party will object to the settlement. The Settling Parties intend to file a stipulation today.
