**RE: RE \_\_\_ PGE Net Metering Annual Billing Cycle Change Request**

Portland General Electric Company (PGE) hereby submits pursuant to Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) 860-039-0055(2), alternative annual billing cycles for net metering customers.

The OAR states:

*Unless the public utility and the customer-generator otherwise agree, the annual billing cycle will end at the end of the March billing month of each year. Should the public utility and a customer-generator reach an agreement for a billing cycle ending other than at the end of the March billing month, the public utility must inform the Commission in writing of the alternative billing period within 30 calendar days of the agreement's execution.*

PGE recently discovered it was not notifying the Commission of alternative annual billing cycles. This filing includes notifications from 2019 and 2020. PGE has adopted a simple form with the customer information to submit to the OPUC. Due to customer sensitive information, the forms will be sent to the Filing Center under separate cover and marked as Confidential Information under OAR 860-001-0070.
