customers in the Pacific Northwest, with offices in Portland, Oregon. A list of ICNU members is

included as Attachment A. Many members of ICNU are customers of PacifiCorp and Portland

General Electric Company ("PGE"), as indicated on Attachment A.

On June 19, 2013, PacifiCorp and PGE (the "Companies") filed a request 4.

for a generic investigation into the power cost adjustment mechanisms ("PCAMs") currently in

place for the two Companies. Following discussions with interested parties, including ICNU, the

Companies filed another request on March 21, 2014, which asked the Commission to narrow its

investigation to the issue of the recovery of costs incurred by the Companies to comply with

Oregon's Renewable Portfolio Standard ("RPS"). Any adjustment to how such costs are

recovered will substantially and directly affect those of ICNU's members who purchase power

from PGE and PacifiCorp. ICNU requests leave to intervene in this Docket to represent its

members who are affected by any change to PGE's and PacifiCorp's rates.

ICNU opposes the Commission opening an investigation into the 5.

Companies' PCAMs. The Commission recently adopted a PCAM for PacifiCorp and rejected

PacifiCorp's argument that the RPS justifies a change in the standard Oregon PCAM.

ICNU represents the interests of a number of large electric customers 6.

served by PacifiCorp and PGE in Oregon. ICNU has significant experience participating in
