12	Protective Order to protect commercially sensitive and confidential business information		
13	related to the Company's proposed tariff for the provision of Large Volume Non-Residentia		
14	High Pressure Gas Service.		
15	In support of this Motion, the Company states:		
16	1. The Commission's rules author	rize NW Natural to seek reasonable restrictions on	
17	discovery of trade secrets and other confidential business information. See OAR 860-001		
18	0080; ORCP 36(C)(7) (providing protection against unrestricted discovery of "trade secrets or		
19	other confidential research, development	t, or commercial information"). See also Re	
20	Investigation into the Cost of Providing Telecommunication Service, Docket UM 351, Order		
21	No. 91-500 (1991) (recognizing that protective orders are a reasonable means to protect "the		
22	rights of a party to trade secrets and other confidential commercial information" and "to		
23	facilitate the communication of information between litigants").		
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1	2. On October 29, 2013, the	Commission suspended NVV Natural's Advice No. 13-	
2	10 and opened this docket. It is expected that certain documents related to the provision of		
3	Large Volume Non-Residential High Pressure Gas Service will contain confidential material		
4	Public disclosure of the confidential information could be detrimental to NW Natural and its		
5	customers.		
6	3. It is substantially likely	that the parties to UG 266 will seek to discover	
7	confidential business information. "The Commission's standard blanket protective order i		
8	designed to facilitate discovery in cases involving discovery of large numbers of documents.		
9	See In re Portland Extended Area Service Region, Docket UM 261, Order No. 91-958 (1991)		
0	Issuance of a protective order will facilitate the production of relevant information and expedite		
1	the discovery process.
