Re: UM 1514 Automated Demand Response – Interim Report

In accordance with the timeline PGE established for its Automated Demand Response pilot (ADR or Energy Partner) and the OPUC Staff's request for interim reporting, attached is PGE's interim report for the winter 2015 operating season. PGE's primary goal for the season was to continue to expand program participation, and call demand response events as appropriate. Highlights of ADR's fourth operating season include:

- Because of the unusually mild weather, PGE called only one event during the winter season with curtailment below the contracted amount.
- PGE continues to expand the program. As of March 30, 2015, EnerNOC had signed contracts from 27 customers to participate in the pilot. EnerNOC estimates the summer 2015 capacity for this group of customers to be approximately 8.5 MW, and they hope to sign and enable several more customers before the summer 2015 season begins. Although these are still subject to acceptance testing and equipment installation, PGE appears to be behind achieving its summer 2015 goal of 12 MW enabled on the program. We believe, however, that an increase in market education and focus on Distributed Standby Generation customers should lead to increased enrollments.
