STATUS REPORT

10 On June 16, 2015, the administrative law judge (ALJ) issued a ruling holding this matter  
11 in abeyance and directing parties to submit a status report no later than August 6, 2015,  
12 indicating whether the parties wished to continue the abeyance or have the ALJ schedule a  
13 prehearing conference to establish a procedural schedule for the remainder of this docket.  
14 Staff files this status report to let the ALJ know that the parties would like to continue the  
15 abeyance to continue working on a legislative proposal that may address the issues underlying  
16 this docket.

17 The parties have met to discuss potential legislative proposals and will meet again on  
18 August 26, 2015. Staff asks that the ALJ continue the abeyance until October 26, 2015. Parties  
19 will update the ALJ on or before that date indicating whether they would like the abeyance  
20 continued or would like the ALJ to schedule a prehearing conference to establish a procedural
