

RULING

DISPOSITION:        PETITIONS TO INTERVENE GRANTED

NW Energy Coalition (NVEC), Portland General Electric Company (PGE), PacifiCorp, dba Pacific Power, Industrial Users of Northwest Utilities (ICNU), and Energy Trust of Oregon (ETO) filed petitions to intervene in this docket. No objections were filed to any of the petitions within the allotted time period. Upon review of the petitions, I find that NVEC, PGE, PacifiCorp, ICNU, and ETO have sufficient interest in the proceedings to participate and that their participation will not unreasonably broaden the issues, burden the record, or delay the proceedings.<sup>1</sup> The petitions to intervene are granted.
