1. **DIRECTORY ASSISTANCE SERVICE**

A. General

Directory Assistance Service gives customers access to telephone numbers of individuals or businesses by dialing 555-1212, 4-1-1 or 1-4-1-1.

B. Definitions

- Local numbers are any NPA/NXXs within the customer's local calling area or home NPA.
- 2. National numbers are any NPA/NXXs within the United States, Canada, Puerto Rico and the U.S. Virgin Islands, but outside the customer's local calling area or home NPA.
- 3. Call Completion is when a customer requests that a call be completed to the number that was provided during the directory assistance call. (N)

C. Regulations

- 1. A maximum of two requested telephone numbers is allowed per call.
- Rates will apply based on the NPA/NXX requested.

3. Charges for Directory Assistance Service for requests of a local or national number are not applicable to calls placed from customers whose physical, visual, or reading handicaps prevent them from using the telephone directory.

- 2. National numbers are any NPA/NXXs within the United States, Canada, Puerto Rico and the U.S. Virgin Islands, but outside the customer's local calling area or home NPA.
- International numbers are numbers from outside the United States, Canada, Puerto Rico and the U.S. Virgin Islands.
- c. 3. Call Completion is when a customer regions that a call
 - A maximum of two requested telephone numbers is allowed per call.
 - 2. Rates will apply based on the NPA/NXX requested.
 - (3) Call allowances apply to requests for local numbers only.
- Charges for Directory Assistance Service for requests of a local or national number are not applicable to calls placed from customers whose physical, visual, or reading handicaps prevent them from using the telephone directory. Calls requesting international numbers will be charged the applicable rate.
 - When a subscriber requests the assistance of a long distance operator to obtain a listing from the directory assistance operator, a surcharge of \$1.00 per listing requested will apply in addition to Rates 2.B. above.

The Commission will investigate the rate increase if it receives petitions signed by 10 percent of customers or 500, whichever is the lesser, on or before April 21, 2015. If the Commission does not receive sufficient petitions by April 21, the proposed rates will become effective on May 1 without Commission review. Petitions should be sent to the Commission's Consumer Services Division. The Company will provide a current copy of the local exchange directory and its service territory map within ten days of a request from any customer.
