**SUBJECT:** Canby Telephone Association, Advice No. 12: Revises Canby Telephone Association's Tariff PUC Or. No.3, Access Services by introducing one (1) new service, reducing two (2) rate elements and stating Mt. Angel's concurrence with Ethernet Transport Service.

I have reviewed this filing and recommend that an acknowledgement letter be sent. The filing was submitted on April 3, 2015 and will go into effect on May 4, 2015. On April 15, 2015, additional information and revisions to the original filing were submitted at the request of Staff.

This filing revises Canby Telephone Association's Tariff PUC Or. No.3, Access Services as required by the FCC' regulations in 47 CFR § 51.913(a)(2). Effective July 1, 2014, originating Access Reciprocal Compensation for access traffic exchanged between a local exchange carrier and another telecommunications carrier in Time Division Multiplexing (TDM) format that originates and/or terminates in Internet Protocol (IP) format shall be subject to a rate equal to the relevant interstate originating access charges.

This filing introduces Interoffice Transport, reduces rates for 500 Mbps and 1 Gig elements in three year term agreements and formalizes Mt. Angel's concurrence with Ethernet Transport Service. Check sheets No. 5 and No. 6 are revised; Tariff sheets No. 222 and No. 234 are revised; and Tariffs sheets No. 234.1 and 274.1 are added.

This filing will not cause the withdrawal of service, or conflict with other schedules and should not raise revenue for the corresponding Companies.
