RE: Supplemental Filing of Advice No. 15-13, Schedule 105, Regulatory Adjustments, Fee Free Bankcard Program Expenses Refund

Portland General Electric (PGE) submits this supplemental filing pursuant to Oregon Revised Statutes 757.205 and 757.210, and Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) 860-022-0025, for filing proposed tariff sheets associated with Tariff P.U.C. No. 18. PGE initially filed Advice No. 15-13 on May 12, 2015 with a requested effective date of July 1, 2015, which remains the same. This supplemental filing corrects entries in the proposed Adjustment Rates.

To satisfy the requirements of OAR 860-022-0025(2), PGE provides the following response as originally filed:

The proposed change in Schedule 105 prices results in an annualized decrease of approximately \$0.7 million to applicable customers, or a 0.04% decrease overall. There are approximately 836,000 applicable customers as of July 2015. A typical Schedule 7 Residential customer consuming 840 kWh monthly will see a bill decrease of \$0.07 or 0.07%.

The requirements of OAR 860-022-0030(1) do not apply to this filing because PGE is proposing a decrease in prices rather than an increase.

A corrected work paper is also included.

SCHEDULE 105 REGULATORY ADJUSTMENTS

PURPOSE

The purpose of this schedule is to reflect the effects of regulatory adjustments such as net gains from nonrecurring property transactions, and costs associated with the implementation of SB 1149, and miscellaneous nonrecurring items.

APPLICABLE

To all bills for Electricity Service calculated under all schedules and contracts, except those Customers explicitly exempted.

PART A - MISCELLANEOUS ADJUSTMENTS

Part A will be adjusted annually as necessary to recover nonrecurring Regulatory Adjustments.

PART B - LARGE NON-RESIDENTIAL LOAD TRUE-UP

Part B consists of costs associated with the Schedule 128 Large Nonresidential Load Shift True-up after the November annual open enrollment window.
