SUBJECT: United Telephone Company of the Northwest, PL 26/Advice No. 15-014, Compliance filing with Order No. 15-341 in UD 27 to move Business Bundle to the Price List (from the Tariff).

I have reviewed this filing and recommend that an acknowledgement letter be sent. The filing is being made in compliance with Order No. 15-341 in docket UD 27, which was issued on October 20, 2015. The filing went into effect on October 28, 2015, and was received on October 27, 2015. This filing places the Business Bundle (package) in the price list and a companion regular tariff filing, ADV 120/Advice No. OR15-09, removes the service from the company's tariff.

United Telephone Company of the Northwest dba CenturyLink (United) and CenturyTel of Oregon, Inc. dba CenturyLink (CenturyTel) filed a *joint petition* to price list their respective Business Bundle offerings for business customers pursuant to ORS 759.054 and OAR 860-032-0035. The petition was filed September 25, 2015, and came before the Commission at its October 20, 2015, public meeting.

The disposition of the docket is that the petition is granted with conditions for the company to price list Business Bundle. The initial rate for the service would be the current tariff rate.

The order sets these conditions: (1) the individual services/features included in the service package remain available separately in the company's tariff, (2) the total prices of the service package shall not exceed the sum of the tariffed rates of the individual service components included in the package, and (3) the decision to grant the petition is made without prejudice to future decisions regarding whether any particular services are essential or nonessential, or whether any particular service package should be price-listed when some of the underlying services are tariffed.
