SUBJECT: Frontier Communications Northwest Inc., Advice No. 041SPL
Corrects the descriptions for Selective Call Forward and Selective
Call Acceptance features.

I have reviewed this filing and recommend that an acknowledgement letter be sent. The filing went into effect December 11, 2015, and was filed December 10, 2015. The company proposes to correct the Customized Local Area Signaling Service (CLASS) feature descriptions for Selective Call Forward and Selective Call Acceptance in the price list.

Selective Call Forward allows a customer to program up to 15 telephone numbers to be forwarded automatically to another telephone number.

Selective Call Acceptance allows a customer to select specific telephone numbers from which calls are to be received.

The proposed corrections to the service descriptions for the two features are improvements over the previous descriptions.

The filing complies with Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) 759.175, which requires telecommunications utilities to submit tariff filings to the Commission whenever a telecommunications utility intends to change its rates, terms, or conditions of service. This filing was submitted on December 10, 2015, and thus, complies with Frontier *Price Plan*, Section Q, which requires price list changes to be filed at least one day prior to their effective dates
