Pursuant to Section 7.3 of the Third Amended and Restated Intervenor Funding Agreement ("IFA") approved by the Oregon Public Utility Commission ("Commission") by Order No. 15-335 (October 20, 2015), the Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities ("ICNU") hereby requests final payment of ICNU's Issue Fund Grant in Docket No. UM 1754 in the amount of \$4,634.67.

On January 14, 2016, ICNU filed its Proposed Budget for Issue Fund Grant in this Docket showing eligible expenses in the amount of \$10,525 and requesting an Issue Fund Grant in the amount of \$8,420. On January 26, 2016, the Commission issued Order No. 16-031, approving an Issue Fund Grant for ICNU in the amount of \$8,420. At this time, ICNU requests final payment of its approved Issue Fund Grant in Docket No. UM 1754 in the amount of \$4,634.67. As described below, ICNU requests that the unused portion the UM 1754 Issue Fund Grant be reallocated to Docket No. UE 307.

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ICNU hereby requests that the Commission authorize final payment of the Issue Fund Grant in the amount of \$4,634.67 from the 2016 PacifiCorp Issue Fund. ICNU's expenses are shown in Confidential Attachment A.

This Request for Payment satisfies the requirements of the IFA as follows:

<u>Section 7.3(a)</u> – The itemized expenses, payees, and hourly rates are attached as Confidential Exhibit A.

<u>Section 7.3(b)</u> – ICNU has been an active participant in this Docket. ICNU has conducted discovery, analyzed PacifiCorp's Renewable Portfolio Standard Implementation Plan, and filed comments. The expenses included in Confidential Exhibit A are reasonable and directly attributable to ICNU's participation in UM 1754.

Section 7.3(c) – The Commission approved ICNU's initial proposed budget on January 26, 2016. In addition, ICNU used its own funds to pay for at least 20% of the Eligible Expenses as required by Section 6.5 of the IFA.

<u>Section 7.3(d)</u> - This Request for Payment constitutes a Final Request for Payment in this Docket.

<u>Section 7.4</u> – All of the expenses included in Exhibit A are Eligible Expenses as defined in Section 7.4 of the IFA because they relate to services provided or expenses incurred by ICNU's outside legal counsel and expert witness. Relevant non-privileged documents substantiating the Eligible Expenses in Confidential Exhibit A are available for Commission audit, if requested, pursuant to Section 7.10 of the IFA.

The IFA provides that the granting of an Issue Fund Grant "shall constitute a binding obligation on the Commission to order reimbursement of Eligible Expenses." IFA § 6.5. Likewise, the intervenor funding rules adopted by the Commission provide that "[t]he terms of an [intervenor funding] agreement are binding on all organizations seeking a grant under that agreement and will be followed by the Commission in administering the agreement."

OAR § 860-001-0120(2). ICNU has satisfied the terms of the IFA and respectfully requests that

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the Commission approve final payment of ICNU's Issue Fund Grant in the amount of \$4,634.67

from the 2016 PacifiCorp Issue Fund within 30 days of receiving this Request for Final Payment

as provided in Section 7.6 of the IFA.

Pursuant to Section 6.7 of the IFA, ICNU requests that the Commission reallocate

the remaining \$3,785.33 of the Issue Fund Grant in this proceeding to Docket No. UE 307.

ICNU expects that its participation in UE 307 will require additional time and resources that

were not foreseen, and which were not outlined in its original proposed budget in that docket.

Also pursuant to Section 6.7 of the IFA, ICNU is filing an amended proposed

budget in UE 307 at the same time it makes this Request for Final Payment and Reallocation of

Issue Fund Grant. Upon payment of this Request for Final Payment and reallocation of funds to

UE 307, the balance of the UM 1754 Issue Fund Grant will be zero, and the balance of ICNU's

Amended Proposed Budget in UE 307 will be \$24,893.33.
