Small Business Utility Advocates ("SBUA") requests permission to file comments out of time in response to PacifiCorp's Renewable Portfolio Standard Implementation Plan 2017-2021 OAR 860-083-0400 Compliance Filing (the "Implementation Plan") in this matter. SBUA would provide such comments no later than February 23, 2016.

The Commission may accept as conditionally received to meet the filing deadline documents required to be filed within a specified time but that fail to substantially comply with these rules. OAR 860-001-0150(4). SBUA acknowledges that it is requesting it be permitted to file comments even though the deadline established by the rules, OAR 860-083-0400(8)(a) is passed. SBUA submits this petition due to time constraints, and finding that these proceedings are important service to its members in light of recent and related energy regulatory events.
