EXPEDITED CONSIDERATION REQUESTED

Pursuant to OAR 860-083-0005(2), Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Staff) requests a waiver of the time set by OAR 860-083-0350(4) for filing its Comments in this docket. This motion is required because Staff's Comments were due under the rule within 45 calendar days of PacifiCorp's filing (i.e. the Comments were due February 12, 2016). *See* OAR 860-083-0350(4). Due to unforeseen circumstances, Staff was not able to meet this deadline but will be filing its Comments today (February 17, 2016).

Staff further requests and recommends that the Administrative Law Judge grant PacifiCorp until March 18, 2016 to respond to its Comments in order to allow the company its full 30 calendar days' response time as permitted by OAR 860-083-0350(4). Staff further notes that the only other event to occur in this docket is for the matter to be considered by the Commission at a future, unscheduled public meeting. Granting Staff's motion will not affect the timing of this final event.


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1 Staff is authorized to state that PacifiCorp, the Citizens' Utility Board of Oregon, and the
